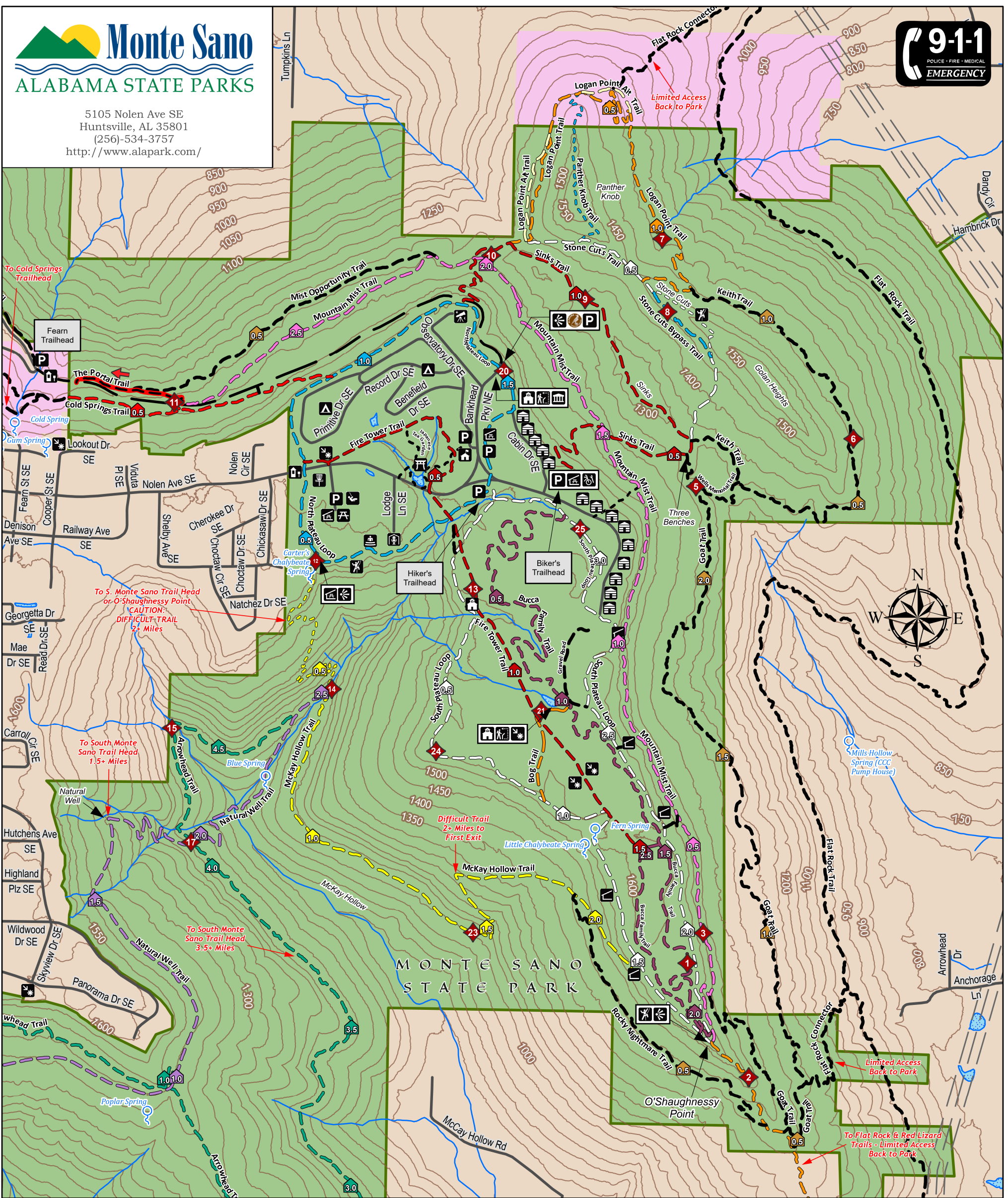
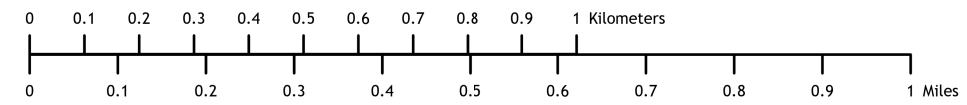

Park Rules

- Stay on trails.
- Pets on a six foot leash.
- Bicyclists ride only on trails or sections of trails that are open to bikes.
- Bicyclists yield to hikers.
- Bicyclists 16 & under must wear a helmet.
- Wait two days after a rain before using trails.
- Rock climbers, boulders, rappellers, & cavers check-in at Park office.
- Take only pictures.
- Trails close 30 minutes before sundown.
- Park closes at sunset.
- A full listing of Park regulations can be obtained from Park office.

PLEASE DON'T USE MUDDY TRAILS

AFTER RAIN
Wait at least a day after rain to allow trails to dry out. Sometimes a couple days are needed.
DURING FREEZE / THAW CYCLE
Use trails while the ground is frozen. Don't use when thawing and muddy. Once above freezing, wait until the trail dries out.
