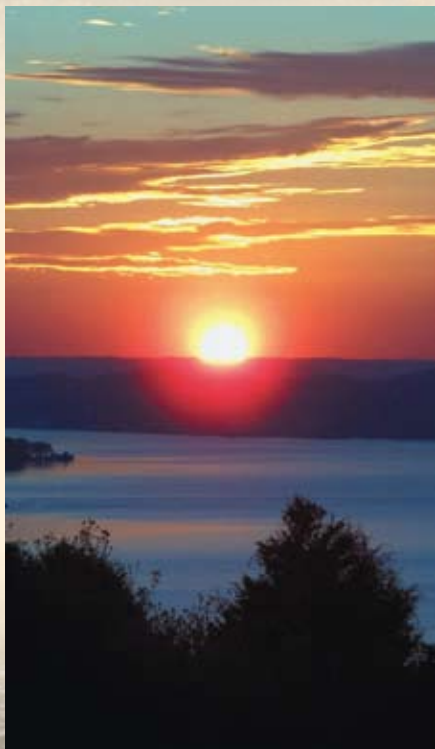

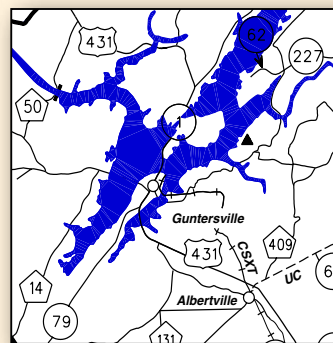
Words can't describe what the eyes behold from the Lake Guntersville State Park Lodge high atop Taylor Mountain. The view, the majestic 69,000 acre Guntersville Reservoir and surrounding mountains, has to be actually experienced in order to be truly appreciated.

Lake Guntersville Resort State Park ranges over 6,000 acres of natural woodlands. The park has an 18-hole championship golf course, a beach complex, fishing center, hiking trails, nature programs and a day use area. Modern campground and lake-view cottages on the lake coupled with a beautiful resort lodge on the pinnacle of Taylor Mountain, and chalets on the ridge-tops provide a selection of overnight accommodations beyond comparison.

The Eagle Awareness program at Lake Guntersville has been so successful that spotting one in flight is no longer an occasional occurrence. Eagle Awareness takes place every weekend during the month of January.

THE LODGE

Lake Guntersville Resort State Park provides a massive resort inn, restaurant and convention complex (Lodge) perfect for your association's next state or regional meeting. The lodge offers private saunas for men and women, a hot tub, exercise room, outdoor pool, wireless internet and a gift shop.

AMENITIES OF THE LODGE

The Meeting Rooms

Meeting facilities are large enough to accommodate a banquet or opening session, along with smaller breakout rooms. The magnificent view of Lake Guntersville will provide an experience not soon to be forgotten.

The Restaurant

The Pinecrest Dining Room and Aquatic Terrace, overlooking the bluff and lake, seats up to 341 people and provides the perfect atmosphere for you and that special someone. The menu features a wide variety of delicious selections, from southern specialties, to beef and seafood dishes, all reasonably priced. Casual attire may be worn in the dining room. The dining room is open year round serving three meals each day.

The Hotel

The lodge hotel provides 99 rooms and 13 suites. Standard rooms provide two queen size beds with pillow top mattresses. Other room amenities included are: refrigerator, microwave oven, color TV, DVD player, ironing board with iron, coffee pot and hair dryer. Most bluff side rooms provide private decks.

Swimming Pool and Hot Tub

The swimming pool and hot tub are open daily during the summer months. They are reserved for the use of Lodge, Chalet and Cottage guests. Children under ten must be accompanied by an adult. No lifeguard is on duty.

Indoor Saunas and Exercise Rooms

Private saunas for both men and women are available in the lodge along with an exercise room. Both are located near the swimming pool area and are reserved for Lodge, Chalet and Cottage guests. A gift shop offers everything from post cards to gift items.

The Chalets and Cottages

Lake Guntersville State Park provides 15 lakeside cottages and 20 mountain top chalets. Chalets have a living room with fireplace, kitchen and two bedrooms with one king and two double beds and a bath. Accessible chalets are available upon request. Cottages have a living room, two bedrooms with a total of one king and two double beds, two baths and kitchen. Televisions are provided in the king-sized bedroom and living room. Other amenities include a DVD Player, iron/ironing board, hair dryer, coffee pot and microwave.



THE PARK

Adjacent to the Lake Guntersville reservoir shoreline you will find the campground among the pine studded woodlands. The campground consists of 321 improved campsites. Ranging from the primitive to the modern, complete with utilities, the sites vary to suit nearly every taste. Campground conveniences include utility connections, tables, grills, bathhouses, hot showers, a camp store, and play areas.

AMENITIES OF THE PARK

The Nature Center

A Nature Center, with a Naturalist, provides interesting interpretive programs.

The Beach and Boat Ramp Area

Sunbathers and water enthusiasts will enjoy the beach area. It consists of a beach pavilion adjacent to the campground along with beautiful sandy beaches. A boat ramp is also available for launching your boat or you can rent one of ours. Transient boat slips are also available.

The Golf Course

Golfers will enjoy the challenging yet beautiful 18-hole championship golf course and pro shop.

The golf course is within walking distance of the lodge. The course provides practice driving, chipping, and putting facilities.

The pro shop provides cart rentals, golfing equipment, color TV, snacks, and showers.

Fishing and Hiking Trails

Lake Guntersville State Park provides marked trails for hikers and horseback riders. Fishing is excellent whether

from a boat or the banks of the river. Fishing tackle

supplies and boat rentals are available

at Town Creek Fishing Center.
