

Looking for the ultimate vacation experience?

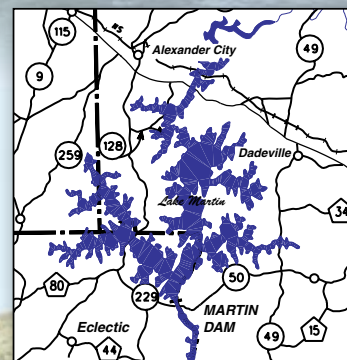

Fishing, Camping, And So Much More!

The Campground lies along the banks of Lake Martin under pine trees so tall they sometimes seem to pierce the clouds above. It is made up of four camping sections and has an overflow area to accommodate extra campers on major holidays. Campfires, outdoor grilling, bicycling and hiking are all part of the camping experience at Wind Creek.

Bathhouses are located throughout the sections of the campground with a playground centrally located. Near the playground is a camp building used by campers for meetings, arts and crafts, bingo and church services. Outside the camp building is an area where local talent can entertain park visitors.

The Beautiful Sandy Beach swimming area is served by a separate bathhouse and parking lot with multiple picnic tables throughout the area.

Hiking Two hiking trails offer the visitor everything from the beauty of wildflowers to white-tail deer. The trails wind over hardwood ridges and through tall pines down the shoreline, offering spectacular views of Lake Martin.

The Silo has long been the focal point of Wind Creek State Park and provides a special view of the lake.

Camping Cabins are a new addition to Wind Creek. These cabins provide the camping experience without having to own a RV or motor home. All you have to bring are your linens and cooking utensils. Four of the cabins sleep up to six people and one cabin is handicapped accessible.

The Fishing Pier gets you away from the crowd and allows you to get closer to that big catch.

The Marina and Country Store will fulfill all your boat, fishing, and camping needs. Pontoon and Jonboat rentals are available. Wetslip boat storage is rented daily and monthly.

Eagle Sightings are no longer a rare occurrence with sightings now being reported at numerous locations near the lake.

Wind Creek provides a huge storage area for campers who prefer not to pull the RV home before the next outing.
