



EIGHTH DAY ESCAPE Contest Rules

HOW TO ENTER:

1. VISIT any Alabama State Park and capture photos as you explore.
2. SUBMIT a contest entry form with photos and a brief recap of your adventure (details below).
3. FOLLOW the Parks Explorer column on alapark.com/explorer for announcement of monthly winner.

Contestants must submit a Contest Entry Form and photos to be eligible for monthly prizes and grand prize at the end of the contest. Entry forms and photos may be submitted within 30 days of trip by any of the following means:

1. Contestants may e-mail their entry form along with digital photos (up to 5 MB) to Parks.Explorer@dcnr.alabama.gov
2. Contestants may post their photos to our Facebook page at <https://www.facebook.com/ALStateParks/>, tweet photos to @ALStateParks, or post to Instagram, tagging @alstateparks. **Indicate where the image was taken and use hashtag #EighthDayEscape for all social media entries. Emailed entry form must accompany all social media photos in order for participant to be eligible.**
3. Contestants may submit entry form and printed photos by mail.

Regardless of entry method, all submissions are subject to the Ownership/Use Rights, Photographer/Rights, and all other rules and conditions included below.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Participants must have visited an Alabama State Park within 30 days of contest entry. Participant will be entered in the monthly drawing based on date of contest entry (i.e. Participants entering from January 8 to February 7 will be entered in the February 8 drawing)
2. Only one entry per household will be allowed each month.
3. To be entered in Grand Prize drawing, participants must submit an entry form and photos for at least one month. Participants may earn up to 12 chances at the Grand Prize (one entry/month). While participants are encouraged to enter each month for improved odds at the grand prize, participants may only win a monthly prize once.
4. A completed entry form and at least one photo is required for participants to be entered into drawings.
5. Employees of the Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources along with members of their household are not eligible to win.
6. Participants under 18 years of age must have signature of legal guardian to participate.

PHOTOGRAPHS

FORMAT:

Entries may be digital images. When submitting digital photos by email, please include the name of the contest participant in the filename. Maximum file size is 5MB. Printed photos may also be submitted, but be aware that no photos will be returned.

PHOTOGRAPHER/COPYRIGHT:

Entries must be submitted by the original photographer. Do not submit a photo taken by someone other than you. You must be the sole owner of the copyright of any image submitted. Your submission of the photo and entry form is your guarantee that you are the author and copyright holder of the photo.

OWNERSHIP/USE RIGHTS:

By entering the contest, photographers agree to grant the Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources and Alabama State Parks the royalty-free and nonexclusive right to distribute, publish and use the photograph(s) in publications and on the Internet as they see fit.

RETURN OF PHOTOS

Photos, regardless of the medium will not be returned. Please do not send your only copy of a photo.
