## **Campground Regulations**


Check-out Time:

AM / PM

- Most parks open at 7:00 AM and close at 9:00 PM. No campers will be admitted after closing hours. (Gulf State Park is open 24 hours.)
- The entrance gate is provided for your security. Only Registered Campers are allowed in the parks after closing hours. Allowing anyone else into the park after closing will result in your immediate expulsion.
- Quiet hours are enforced from 10:00 PM until 6:00 AM
- Minors (under 18 years of age) must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Only one camping unit is allowed per site. A camping permit is required before setting up
- · Tents or RV's should immediately occupy the assigned campsite after registration is completed.
- Maximum occupancy per site is: 8 persons & 2 motor vehicles. Occupancy is limited to 14 days, April 1 through October 31, in most parks.
- · Campers must provide their own camping equipment suitable for the locations; all equipment is subject to the Park Management's approval.
- No open fires are permitted except in grills provided at each campsite or in areas specifically designated by Park Management.
- ALL FIREARMS OR FIREWORKS OF ANY TYPE ARE PROHIBITED.
- All motor vehicles must have valid license plates and be operated by a licensed driver. Vehicles can only be operated on established roadways designated for their specific use. Indiscriminate riding back and forth through the park or campgrounds is strictly forbidden.
- All campsite trash must be deposited in the dumpsters that are provided NOT in the bathhouse or other facility trash receptacles within the park.
- You must use a suitable holding fixture for all waste water and dispose of it properly. Drainage of water, soap, grease or any other waste product onto the ground or into anything other than an approved holding tank or the sewage receptacles and dump stations provided is a violation of Alabama State Law.
- Pets must be kept on a leash. They are not allowed on park beaches or within park buildings.
- · At some parks, the entrance registration station may not be manned all day. In this case, you may obtain a camping permit by filling out an envelope and depositing the required fee.
- · Complete Alabama State Parks Rules and Regulations are posted in conspicuous locations within each Alabama State Park.




