

Rules & Regulations

- Speed Limit is 15 mph on main roadways; 5 mph in campground loops, beach and picnic areas.
- Check-Out is 2:00 PM.
- Quiet hours are enforced from 10:00 PM until 6:00 AM.
- Cannot run generators on RVs.
- No campground visitors are allowed to enter or remain in the park after 9:00 PM. Entrance fees apply to all campground visitors.
- No golf carts allowed. Any battery, gas or mechanically propelled scooters, children's vehicles, etc. are prohibited. Only licensed vehicles shall be allowed to be utilized by the public on any roadway in the park.
- Only one camping unit per site. "Doubling Up" is not allowed. No tents for storage.
- Maximum occupancy per site, 8 persons, 2 motor vehicles. Nightly rate based on 4 persons and one camping unit. Persons 5 to 8 additional costs apply.
- RV or Sleeping tent must occupy site immediately after registering. Canopies, dining tents, or other type structures are NOT considered as a "sleeping tent". Only a sleeping tent can be used to hold a site until the RV arrives; then the tent must be removed. The tent **MUST** be erected on the site; not thrown on the ground. **If not done**, the card will be removed from the post and camp site rented to someone else. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- Pets must be kept on a leash. They are not allowed on beaches, buildings, etc. Please obtain a complete Pet Policy at time of registration.
- Minors under age 14 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- All motor vehicles must have state license, be operated by a licensed driver and on established roadways designated for their use only. Indiscriminate riding back and forth is strictly prohibited.
- Drainage of water, soap, grease or any other waste product onto the ground or into anything other than an approved holding tank or the sewage

- receptacles and dump station provided is a violation of state law. Use a suitable holding fixture for ALL wastewater and dispose of properly.
- The entrance gate is provided for your security. Allowing anyone else into the park after closing will result in your expulsion. Giving out the security gate code to unregistered campers is prohibited.
- No open fires are permitted except in the grills or fire pits at each campsite.
- Deposit trash in dumpster as you leave. Dumpsters are provided at the front and back of the park for your convenience. Do not place your trash in bathhouses or other facility trash receptacles within the park.
- No cutting of trees, branches or bushes is allowed. Pick up downed wood only for campfire. Chainsaws not allowed in the park.
- Swimming allowed at the beach area only. No swimming from campsites.
- Washing vehicles, campers, trailers, boats, etc. is not allowed.
- Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed on **your campsite only**. Walking around the campground or in the beach area with alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
- Alabama Fishing License is required to fish in the lake.
- Fish shall be taken by rod and reel or pole and line only. Use of other methods of fishing such as trotlines, set hooks, gigs, nets, spearguns, bow and arrow, etc. is prohibited.
- All Alabama Boating Laws and Regulations apply.

Complete park rules and regulations are posted in conspicuous locations in the park and are available in brochure form at the entrance registration station.

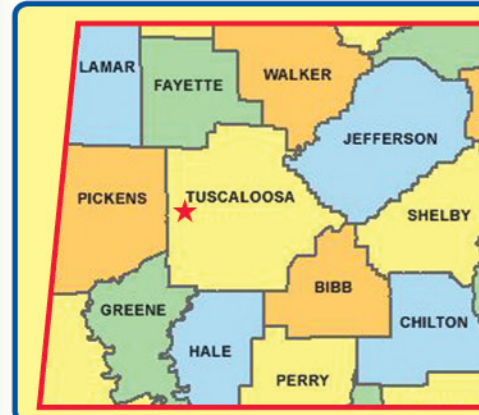

SEVERE WEATHER WARNING

If severe weather threatens, all park users should keep informed of the latest updates through television (Station 33/40) and/or radio (FM 101.7, 92.9, 95.3) or any local stations that you can receive. Lake Lurleen State Park is located in Coker, Alabama, Tuscaloosa County. Lake Lurleen has a severe weather warning siren located on the park that is activated by the Tuscaloosa County EMA. If this siren is activated, Lake Lurleen and surrounding areas are under a **TORNADO WARNING**. Please respond accordingly. The park does not require, but recommends campers leave their camping unit and move to a more substantial building. Bathhouses are located in camping areas "A", "C" and "D", and are safer than remaining in your camping unit.

Pet Policy

- No animal of any type is allowed in any park building, including bathhouses. This rule does not apply to service dogs used by disabled persons.
- All pets must be kept on a leash not longer than six feet at all times. This rule applies to ALL areas of the park, including but not limited to roadways, parking lots, campsites, pavilions and ALL trails.
- **Pets are not allowed in the beach area, adjacent grassy areas, beach bathhouse, parking lot and adjoining picnic shelter. Signs are posted at each end of the beach parking lot designating the beginning of the restricted area.**
- Pets may swim in the lake, but must be leashed immediately upon exiting the water.
- Pets that are noisy, vicious, dangerous or disturbing to other persons will not be allowed to remain in the park. This includes barking dogs that are inside any type of camping unit, vehicle, or tied up outside.


