Position: Grounds Crew Maintenance

As part of the Gulf State Park Staff, this employee would do a variety of jobs that are essential in maintaining cleanliness and operation of the Gulf State Park. This employee will need to be capable of the following duties:

Duties including but not limited to:

- Operating lawn mowers
- Operating weed eaters
- Collecting trash from park
- Using various gardening tools
- Trimming shrubs and trees
- Other maintenance duties

This is a 40 hour per week position starting at 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Must be able to work weekends and holidays as needed.

The starting pay for this position will be \$10.39 and after 10 months of work, an evaluation will be completed prior to a mandatory layoff period of two months. Based on the employee's performance and skill level, the employee may be rehired (after the required 2 month layoff) in the same department or transfer to another department within the park if there is an opening.

Regulations pertaining to salary and benefits are governed by State Personnel and cannot be negotiated.
