

## Independence Day Flag-Making Contest

## **Rules & Regulations**

- All Materials used in flag construction must be natural in <u>origin</u>. Examples: Leaves, Bark, Lichens, Rocks, Twigs, Feathers, <u>Dead Insects</u>, berries etc...
- 2. No Living Material May Be Used. Any animal or plant killed for the construction of the flag will be grounds for disqualification. NO green leaves. Lichens and mosses may be used.
  - 3. Any Age person is eligible to enter a flag.
  - 4. Flags may have any design or theme. Examples: Patriotic, Family, Native American, Favorite Animal, Desoto State Park, Environmental Theme etc...Samples can be found at the Nature Center.
  - 5. Flags must be turned in at the <u>Nature Center</u> next to the Country Store by <u>9:00 a.m.</u> on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>July 1</u>, <u>2023</u>.
- 6. Flags will be judged on neatness, originality, and use of materials.
- 7. Hot glue gun and other materials will be available for use at the Campground Pavilion in the Improved Campground starting Thursday, June 29th. Please do not remove glue supplies from pavilion, this will ensure equal use.
  - 8. Winners will be announced at the Ice Cream Social located at the campground pavilion in the Improved Campground at 4:00 p.m. on Saturday July the 1st & posted on DSP's social media.
