Position: Maintenance Technician

Duties and Responsibilities:

- As part of the Gulf State Park Staff, this employee would do a variety of jobs that are essential in maintaining proper operation of Gulf State Park. This employee will need to be capable of:
- Survey Buildings for potential safety issues
- Perform electrical duties (replace bulbs, receptacles, breakers etc.)
- Assist in HVAC duties
- Maintain plumbing systems
- Inspect alarm systems and repair as needed
- Many other tasks such as Carpentry, painting, spraying herbicides, repairing locks, windows, appliances, and many other various tasks

Requirements and Qualifications:

- Must possess a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Must have previous maintenance experience.

This is a 40 hour per week position starting at 7:00am to 3:00pm.

Must be able to work weekends and holidays. On call shift will also be required.

The starting pay is \$12.80. After 6 months of work, an evaluation and performance appraisal will be completed. Based on the employee's performance and skill level, the employee may be eligible for benefits after a probationary period has been fulfilled.

Regulations pertaining to salary and benefits are governed by State Personnel and cannot be negotiated.
