Camping Regulations

- All campers must register before entering the campground.
- Check-out time is 11 AM.
- Quiet hours are from 10 PM to 6 AM.
- Campers must occupy site immediately after registration.
- Only one camping unit per site! The exception is a family with children under the age of 18 can add one extra tent for a pernight charge. All sites are one flat rate for up to four people with an extra fee per night, per person up to eight people.
- Maximum occupancy per site: eight people, two motor vehicles.
- Occupancy is limited to 14 days March 1 thru November 1.
- Pets must be kept on a leash. They are not allowed on beaches or in buildings.
- Campers must provide their own equipment suitable for the location, subject to the Manager's approval. A camping permit is required before setting up camp.
- A responsible adult must accompany minors under the age of 18. Fires are permitted in fire pits only.
- All motor vehicles must have state license and be operated by a licensed driver on established roadways designated for their use only. Indiscriminate riding back and forth is strictly forbidden.
- All trash must be deposited in the dumpsters on the right as you exit the campground.

Complete State Park Rules and Regulations are posted in a conspicuous location.

- The campground is open for camping year-round.
- RV sites are available with water, electric and sewer hook-ups.
- · Tent sites have water in the vicinity.
- Equestrian Campground (12 Pull Through 50 Amp Full Hook-up sites). Contact Park Staff for more information.




Oak Mountain State Park is located fifteen miles south of Birmingham and is accessible from Interstate 65. Exit 246.




