Boat rentals from our Town Creek Fishing Center include bass boats, canoes, pontoons, and flat bottom fishing boats. Saturday morning guided nature hikes are led by the park's naturalist and follow portions of our 31 miles of hiking and biking trails. Winter Eagle Awareness Programs take place on weekends during January and February. Our renovated 18-hole championship golf course is ranked among the best in the state.

Welcome to beautiful Lake Guntersville State Park! Nestled among the pines and hardwoods, this park overlooks the majestic 69,000 acre Lake Guntersville and ranges over 6,000 acres of ridge tops and meadows. This park is located seven miles northeast of downtown Guntersville, Alabama, off AL Highway 227.

The Lodge complex rests on the brow of Taylor Mountain and offers one of the most picturesque views of all the state parks. It boasts 112 lodge rooms and suites, fine dining, ample meeting and banquet space, and much more. Lakeside cottages, mountain-top chalets, and two campgrounds situated along the water's edge round out the mix of the distinctive accommodations.

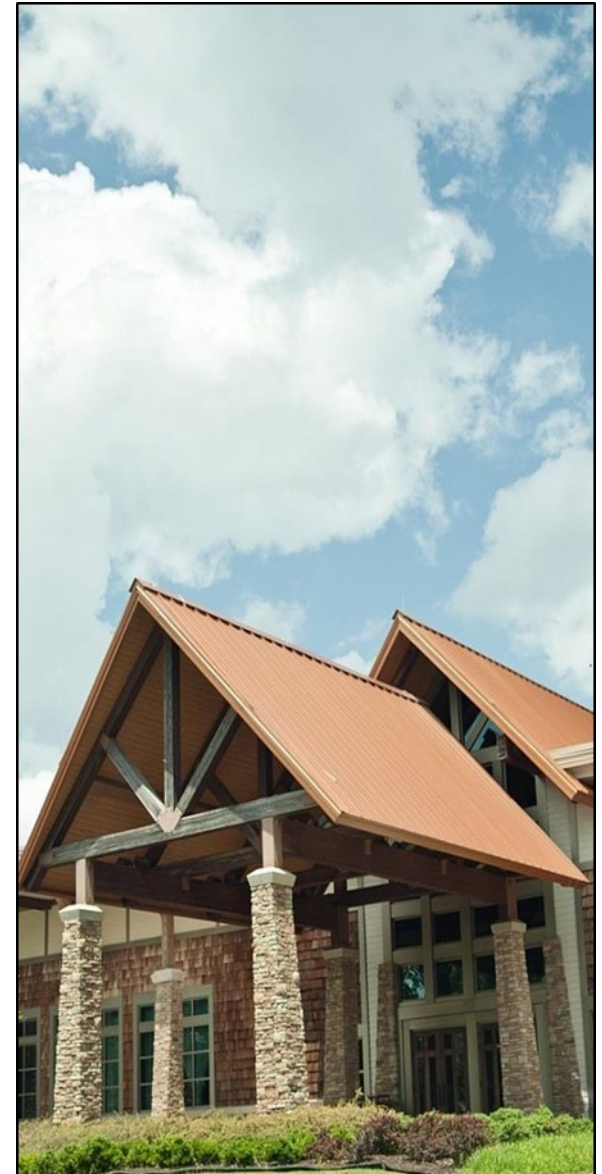
