

**FieldLab: Science Beyond the Classroom** is a hands-on field trip designed for students to explore real-world research and species identification in action. Students will hike approximately 2 miles round trip to visit a gopher tortoise habitat, where they'll observe a live burrow scoping and learn about this keystone species. Along the trail, they'll dive into Birding 101 and practice techniques for identifying both birds and native plants. The program includes time for lunch in the field before the group returns, offering an immersive experience in local ecology and fieldwork skills.

Grades: 7th - 12th grade

Group Size Limit: 20 - 30 students

Length of Field Trip: 3 hours with 30 minute break for lunch
